

Minutes of meeting of Horticultural
Society held in the library of Hall on
Friday evening 29th Feb 1924.

In the absence of the president Mr Wilson
the Rev Mr Cumming moved that the
Rev Mr Crocket take the chair who on
doing so spoke of the desirability of
carrying on the Society as in the past,
and asked Mr Chisholm to read the
minutes of the last meeting of the Society
held in March 1923. The minutes showed
that as the Society failed to find any-
one to take over the duties of Secy &
Treasurer the holding of a show be put
off for that year and that a meeting
of the members be called about the
1st March ¹⁹²⁴ to consider further action.

Mr Chisholm after reviewing the financial position of the Society moved that an honorarium of £100 was be attached to the office of Secy, and that Mr John Tait, Gifford be appointed to that office. This was seconded by the Rev. Mr. Cumming and agreed to. Other office bearers were elected as in 1923 and it was remitted to the Com. of Management to make what additions and alterations to the prize list they considered necessary with a recommendation to encourage the Industrial Section by giving one or two more prizes in it.

The date for holding the Annual Show was fixed for 30th Augt.
