Also to strike out no. 21. and supplement a Table Decoration

of Cut Flowers if it should meet the approval of Mr Donaldson, Tweeddale Arms, who has given the Special Prize. In the Industrial Section a competition for Black Currant Jam was agreed upon. Prizes- 2/6, 1/6, 1/- Class VII. Best Display of Flowers growing in a Window Box to be exhibited in Show and made open.

Mr Bell, seconded by Mr P. Blair, put forward an amending motion to Rule III., that no two members from the one house show in the same competition.

Mr Chisholm, seconded by Mr W. Todd moved that the reading of Rule III. should stand exactly as it is. On a vote being taken Mr Bell's motion was carried. After further consideration a qualifying

Motion was put forth and agreed
to by the majority, that only one
member from same house may
show in any competition in Class I
Vegetables. Class III (excepting nos.
5, 6, and 23) Flowers, and Class IV
Fruit.
